What separates us from God: Very often we say that God is important in our life, is this true? Because if so, I can not understand why some people bring their phone to the Church, instead of leaving it in the car. Some ,even answer the phone during our Mass celebration. He/she ends up leaving the Mass. I think the only ones who have a reason of having the phone in the Church are the doctors. Please, put your phone on vibrate. I also do not understand why some people arrive late and leave before the final blessing. What is more important that does not allow you to arrive on time, to pray and prepare for the Eucharist? Enjoy the Mass, dedicate time to God, and choose God.

No Flowers During Lent: I would like to remind you that during the time of Lent, the Church does not allow decoration with flowers on the altar, or for our Lady. Lent reminds us of the 40 days of Jesus in the desert.

When taking Communion: Some people sometimes scare me when it comes to receiving communion. The correct way to receive Holy Communion is: left hand above the right (open), right hand below in the form of a cross and at the end the Host is taken with the right hand. Which must be consumed immediately. When you receive it in your mouth, please open your mouth wide. The priest or the Eucharistic Minister, do not know if you want to receive Communion or only receive a blessing. To receive the blessing cross your hands and with the palms of your hands touch your shoulders.

Pray For: I would like to invite you to take time to pray to God during this Lenten Season. That He will help us to repent from the heart. To help us to accept the Gospel without conditions, and to forgive those who have offended us. And pray for the victims of the tragedy in Florida. Also, please pray for the family of Father Rudd.

Que nos Separa de Dios: Muy a menudo decimos que Dios es el más importante en nuestra vida, ¿será eso verdad? Porque de ser así, yo no puedo entender porque algunas personas se traen el teléfono para la Iglesia, en lugar de dejarlo en el carro. Peor aún, algunos hasta contestan el teléfono en plena celebración . Finalmente terminan saliéndose de la Santa Misa. Creo que los únicos que tienen la excusa de tener el teléfono en la Iglesia son los médicos, o aquellos que tienen una verdadera razón/excusa para hacerlo. Por favor, ponerlo en vibración. Tampoco entiendo porque algunas personas llegan tarde y se retiran antes de la bendición final. Qué fue más importante que no le permitiera llegar con tiempo, para orar y prepararse para la Eucaristía? O, qué o quién es más importante para que se salga de la Iglesia antes de la bendición final?. Disfrute la Misa, dedíquele tiempo a Dios, no lo cambie por nada ni por nadie.

No Flores: Quiero recordarles, que durante este tiempo de Cuaresma, la Iglesia no permite decoración con flores en el altar, ni siquiera para la Virgen. Ya que estamos en tiempo de Cuaresma, el cual nos recuerda los 40 días de Jesús en el desierto.

Cuidado con la Comunión: Algunas personas, a veces me asustan a la hora de comulgar por la forma en que reciben la comunión, tanto en la mano como en la boca. La forma correcta de recibir la Sagrada Comunión es: mano izquierda arriba de la derecha (abiertas), mano derecha debajo en forma de cruz y al final se toma la Hostia con la mano derecha. La cual debe ser consumida de inmediato. Cuando la reciban en la boca, abran bien la boca. Sea el sacerdote o el Ministro de Eucaristía no sabemos si quieren comulgar o solamente recibir la bendición. Para recibir la bendición se cruzan las manos y con las palmas se tocan los hombros.

Orar Por: Quiero invitarlos a que durante este tiempo, oremos a Dios para que él nos ayude a arrepentirnos de corazón por el mal causado. Para que nos ayude a aceptar el Evangelio sin condiciones, a perdonar a los que nos han ofendido. Y oremos por las victimas y el causante de la tragedia en Florida, al igual que orar por la familia del padre Rudd.

2017—A Look Back
St. Paul's Outreach at St. Paul's the Apostle Catholic Church

We wish to thank all of our parishioners and visitors for your continued support and contributions to St. Paul's Outreach of St. Paul's Catholic Church. Without your help, we could not have completed the following activities during 2017.

We continued the once-monthly **Mobile Food Pantry**. Volunteers at this event are members of Women's Guild, Knights of Columbus and various other church members. We distributed 100,900 pounds of food to 860 families in White County in 2017.

We also continued the **Brown Bag Program** once a month. Church members distribute brown bags to parishioners at each Mass. Parishioners then fill the bags with non-perishable food items. Parishioners return the bags the following Sunday. The bags are then gathered and delivered to those in need. During 2017, we delivered 316 Brown Bags (a total of approx. 7,000 pounds of food).

Client Interviews- We have a team of six parishioners who meet once a month to interview clients that need help with prescription costs, power, propane, water bills, and food. In addition, we have a list of resources to which the clients are referred where there is more help available.

In 2017 we interviewed 92 families and were able to help 70 families.

Jessie Tree - During the 2017 Holiday season, Christmas gifts were distributed to 95 parishioner's children. Our gratitude goes to the Women of St. Paul's, St. Paul's Outreach, the Knights of Columbus, employees of NOK along with our own parishioners who generously donated to this effort.

We encourage everyone in the parish to pray about how you can give back. Consider donating a few hours one day a month at the Mobile Food Pantry or at the Outreach Client Interviews one morning a month.

Again, a sincere thank you for all you do in a time of such great need.

We hope that you will continue to use the blue envelopes or online for donations to St. Paul's Outreach.

Deseamos agradecer a todos nuestros feligreses y visitantes por su continuo apoyo y contribuciones a St. Paul's Outreach de la Iglesia del San Pablo el Apóstol. Sin su ayuda, no podríamos haber completado las siguientes actividades durante el 2017.

Continuamos la despensa de **Comida Móvil** una vez al mes. Los voluntarios en este evento son miembros del Gremio de Mujeres, Caballeros de Colón y otros miembros de la iglesia. Distribuimos 100,900 libras de alimentos a 860 familias en el Condado de White en el 2017.

También continuamos el **Programa Bolsas Café** una vez al mes. Los miembros de la iglesia distribuyen bolsas a los feligreses en cada Misa. Los feligreses llenan las bolsas con alimentos no perecederos. Los parroquianos devuelven las bolsas el domingo siguiente. Las bolsas se juntan y se entregan a los necesitados. Durante el 2017, entregamos 316 bolsas (un total de aproximadamente 7.000 libras de alimentos).

Entrevistas: contamos con un equipo de seis feligreses que se reúnen una vez al mes para entrevistar a personas que necesitan ayuda con los costos de recetas, energía, gas propano, facturas de agua y alimentos. Además, tenemos una lista de recursos a los que se remiten las personas donde hay más ayuda disponible. En 2017 entrevistamos a 92 familias y pudimos ayudar a 70 familias.

Jessie Tree - Durante la temporada de vacaciones de 2017, se distribuyeron regalos de Navidad a 95 niños de la parroquia. Nuestra gratitud va para las Mujeres de San Pablo, St. Paul's Outreach, Caballeros de Colón, empleados de NOK junto con nuestros propios feligreses que donaron generosamente para este esfuerzo.

Alentamos a todos en la parroquia a orar sobre cómo pueden ayudar. Considere donar algunas horas un día al mes en Mobile Food Pantry o en las entrevistas de Outreach Client una mañana al mes.

De nuevo, un sincero agradecimiento por todo lo que hacen en un momento de tanta necesidad.
