

**A Few Words from Fabio**

**Month of the Holy Rosary:**

On the first of October, the Church celebrates the month of the Holy Rosary, a prayer spread by Santo Domingo de Guzmán. The word Rosary means: crown of roses. In the beginning, people recited the 150 psalms, but there were many who could not recite them since they could not read. Therefore, the Church recommended these people to replace the Psalms by 150 Hail Mary's divided into fifteen decades. This short rosary is called the psalter of the Virgin. I want to invite you to pray the Holy Rosary for the needs of the church and especially for those who suffer.

**Month of the Missions:** Do you know who is Father Jimmy Alexander Gil Ocampo? I think most people don't, so let me tell you a little about him. Father Jimmy was ordained in Medellin, Colombia in 2006. He has a specialization in Sacred Scripture and has been working in Kenya, Africa for two years, fulfilling the mission of Christ. Last year we helped them with almost \$ 2000, which was enough to buy around 500 t-shirts and have a Christmas dinner for these children and their families. As you can see it in the back, in the narthex. This year I'd like us to do the same or improve what we did last year. **So: Can I count on you?**

**Fall Festival:** By the time you are reading these lines, our Fall Festival will be over. First of all, I'd like to thank all the people who in one way or another contributed to this event; I ask the God of love and the Blessed Virgin to fill them with many blessings. Without you this would not have been possible. I hope that those who didn't participate, we hope you will join us in the coming up activities that we will continue to have.

**Reflection:** This weekend, the readings invite us to deepen the meaning of family life, the Sacrament of Marriage and the formative role of the family. It is sad to see how many families are in crisis, due to the excessive time they devote to work, technology, and the influence by the different media. As long as God is not the center of the home, it will be difficult, if not impossible, to fulfill the mission and vocation to which God has called them.

**Protection of Children and Young People**

The Archdiocese of Atlanta is committed to helping children and young people learn and grown in a healthy and safe environment. St. Paul parish complies with diocesan safe environment policies and procedures. In accordance with the US Bishop's *Charter for the Protection of Children and Young People*, the program *Protecting God's Children - Teaching Touching Safety* (commonly referred to as Virtus) is used in the Archdiocese of Atlanta. Students in Grades 1 through 10 participate in one or two safety lessons in their first year, and once they move into the next grade group.

The Safe Environment training or Adults of the Archdiocese of Atlanta includes training in how to recognize, prevent and report abuse. All employees and volunteers who regularly work with minors receive this initial training, as well as ongoing training and background screening. The *Code of Conduct, Sexual Abuse Policy, Ministerial Standards for Clergy, Educators and all Working with Children and Vulnerable Individuals, Social Media Policy* as well as the *Charter for the Protection of Children and Young People* are available at the diocesan website, [www.archatl.com](http://www.archatl.com). An overview of the children's training, parent guide, and lesson plans are also available on the diocesan website. We are happy to partner with you in working to keep your children safe.

**CLASSROOM MANNERS**

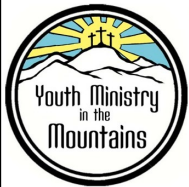

Al principio, en la Iglesia las personas recitaban los 150 salmos, pero eran muchos los que no lo podían recitar ya que no sabían leer. Por lo tanto, la Iglesia recomendó a estas personas que reemplazaran los Salmos por 150 Avemarías divididas en quince decenas. A este rosario corto se le llamo el salterio de la Virgen. Los quiero invitar a que oremos el Santo Rosario por las necesidades de la iglesia y especialmente por los que sufren.
