

Fabio's News**Solemnity of Pentecost**

This weekend we celebrate the Solemnity of Pentecost, the day on which Jesus fulfilled the promise made to the apostles; that the Father would send his Holy Spirit to guide them.

The word Pentecost comes from the Greek word meaning fiftieth, that is, fifty days after Easter Sunday. It was also known as the feast of the weeks, feast of the harvest or day of the first fruits.

There are two characteristic symbols in Pentecost, wind and fire. **The wind:** it is a basic symbol of the Holy Spirit; the Greek word meaning Spirit (Pneuma), also means wind and breath.

Fire: while water meant the birth and fruitfulness of life given in the Holy Spirit, fire symbolizes the transforming energy of the acts of the Holy Spirit.

Pentecost, is considered the second most important week of the liturgical year, after Easter Sunday, during this celebration we have the opportunity to live intensely the relationship between the Resurrection of Christ, his Ascension and the coming of the Holy Spirit, as well as we celebrate the birth of the Holy Mother Church.

Solemnidad de Pentecostés

Este fin de semana la Iglesia Católica celebra la Solemnidad de Pentecostés, día en el que Jesús cumplió la promesa hecha a los apóstoles. La promesa consistía en que el Padre, enviaría el Espíritu Santo para guiarlos en la misión evangelizadora.

La palabra Pentecostés proviene de la palabra griega que significa quincuagésimo, es decir, cincuenta días después del Domingo de Pascua. También se conocía como la fiesta de las semanas, fiesta de la cosecha o día de los primeros frutos.

Hay dos símbolos característicos en Pentecostés que son el viento y el fuego. **El viento:** es un símbolo básico del Espíritu Santo; la palabra griega que significa Espíritu (Pneuma), también significa viento y aliento.

El fuego: mientras el agua significaba el nacimiento y la fecundidad de la vida dada en el Espíritu Santo, el fuego simboliza la energía transformadora de los actos del Espíritu Santo.

Pentecostés, es considerada la segunda semana más importante del año litúrgico, después del Domingo de Resurrección, durante esta celebración nosotros tenemos la oportunidad de vivir intensamente la relación existente entre la Resurrección de Cristo, su Ascensión y la venida del Espíritu Santo, al igual que celebramos el nacimiento de la Santa Madre Iglesia.
