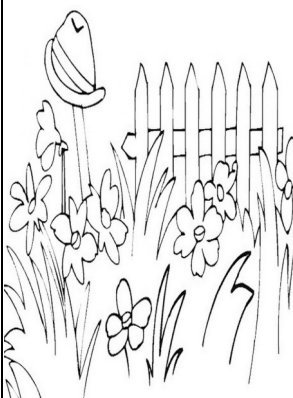
It's time to update our Church Directory. If you would like to volunteer and you are interested to coordinate this project, please contact Fr. Fabio or call the parish office for more info.
