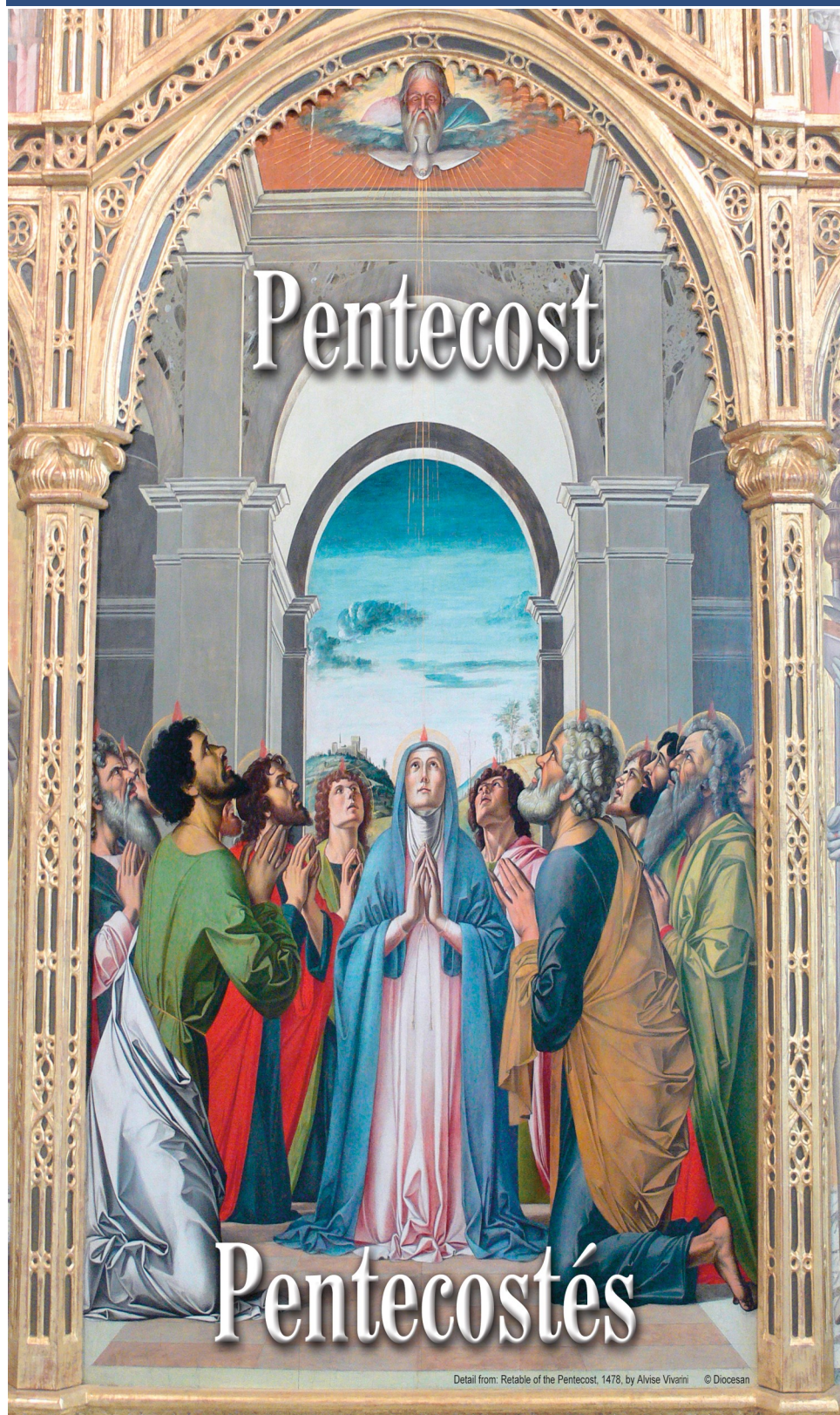

PENTECOST

Pentecost marks the occasion of God sending the Holy Spirit upon Jesus' disciples after his Resurrection. The book of Acts describes how the disciples were gathered together in one place on the day of Pentecost. The Jewish feast of Pentecost (Shavuot or the Feast of Weeks) was a day that commemorated the giving of the law to Moses, a day soon to be marked as well by the giving of the Holy Spirit. The day of Pentecost was a turning point for the disciples: Before Pentecost, the disciples were unsure of what they were to do next and spent most of their time in hiding. After Pentecost and [receiving] the gifts of the Holy Spirit, they understood their mission to spread the Good News of Jesus, and they had the courage to come out of hiding and speak openly about who Jesus was and what he had accomplished by his dying and rising. On Pentecost, the Holy Spirit gave the disciples the strength to fulfill their commission to spread the Good News of Jesus. The Church marks this day through a special liturgical celebration: The Solemnity of Pentecost, on the fiftieth day of Easter, concludes the Easter season. In recent years, the Church has restored the extended vigil for this solemnity. Similar to Easter, the vigil of Pentecost includes four readings from the Old Testament, each with a proper Psalm and prayer, along with the Epistle and Gospel. At the conclusion of the Mass during the Day, the Paschal Candle is extinguished and moved to its permanent location near the baptismal font. The Solemnity of Pentecost, which crowns and fulfills the Easter season, is a good time to pray for a deeper indwelling of the Holy Spirit. *(Taken from USCCB)*

PENTECOSTÉS

Pentecostés marca la ocasión en que Dios envía el Espíritu Santo sobre los discípulos de Jesús después de su Resurrección. El libro de los Hechos describe cómo los discípulos se reunieron en un solo lugar el día de Pentecostés. La fiesta judía de Pentecostés (Shavuot o la Fiesta de las Semanas) fue un día que conmemoró la entrega de la ley a Moisés, un día que pronto será marcado también por la entrega del Espíritu Santo. El día de Pentecostés fue un punto de inflexión para los discípulos: Antes de Pentecostés, los discípulos no estaban seguros de lo que iban a hacer a continuación y pasaban la mayor parte del tiempo escondidos. Después de Pentecostés y [recibir] los dones del Espíritu Santo, entendieron su misión de difundir la Buena Nueva de Jesús, y tuvieron el valor de salir de su escondite y hablar abiertamente sobre quién era Jesús y lo que había logrado con su muerte y resurrección. En Pentecostés, el Espíritu Santo les dio a los discípulos la fuerza para cumplir con su misión de difundir la Buena Nueva de Jesús. La Iglesia celebra este día a través de una celebración litúrgica especial: La solemnidad de Pentecostés, en el quincuagésimo día de Pascua, concluye el tiempo pascual. En los últimos años, la Iglesia ha restablecido la vigilia prolongada por esta solemnidad. Similar a la Pascua, la vigilia de Pentecostés incluye cuatro lecturas del Antiguo Testamento, cada una con un Salmo y una oración apropiados, junto con la Epístola y el Evangelio. Al concluir la Misa durante el Día, el Cirio Pascual se apaga y se traslada a su ubicación permanente cerca de la pila bautismal. La solemnidad de Pentecostés, que corona y cumple la temporada de Pascua, es un buen momento para orar por una morada más profunda del Espíritu Santo. *(Tomado de USCCB)*

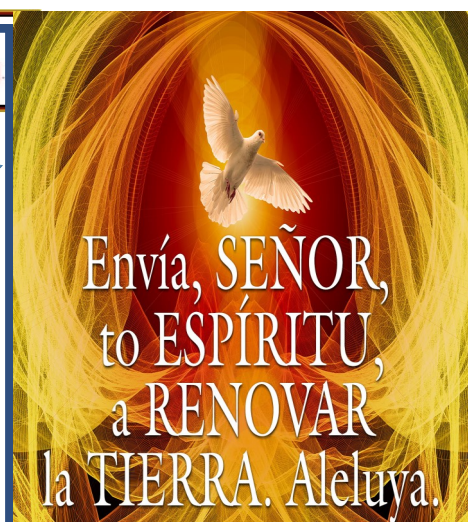
