THE MOST HOLY TRINITY

The mystery of the Most Holy Trinity is the central mystery of the Christian faith and of Christian life. God alone can make it known to us by revealing himself as Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.

The Incarnation of God's Son reveals that God is the eternal Father and that the Son is consubstantial with the Father, which means that, in the Father and with the Father, the Son is one and the same God.

The mission of the Holy Spirit, sent by the Father in the name of the Son (Jn 14:26) and by the Son "from the Father" (Jn 15:26), reveals that, with them, the Spirit is one and the same God. "With the Father and the Son he is worshipped and glorified" (Nicene Creed).

By the grace of Baptism "in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit," we are called to share in the life of the Blessed Trinity, here on earth in the obscurity of faith, and after death in eternal light (Cf. Paul VI, CPG Â§ 9).

"Now this is the Catholic faith: We worship one God in the Trinity and the Trinity in unity, without either confusing the persons or dividing the substance; for the person of the Father is one, the Son's is another, the Holy Spirit's another; but the Godhead of the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit is one, their glory equal, their majesty coeternal" (Athanasian Creed; DS 75; ND 16).

Inseparable in what they are, the divine persons are also inseparable in what they do. But within the single divine operation each shows forth what is proper to him in the Trinity, especially in the divine missions of the Son's Incarnation and the gift of the Holy Spirit. *(Taken from USCCB)*



LA SANTÍSIMA TRINIDAD

El misterio de la Santísima Trinidad es el misterio central de la fe cristiana y de la vida cristiana. Solo Dios nos lo puede dar a conocer revelándose a sí mismo como Padre, Hijo y Espíritu Santo.

La Encarnación del Hijo de Dios revela que Dios es el Padre eterno y que el Hijo es consustancial con el Padre, lo que significa que, en el Padre y con el Padre, el Hijo es uno y el mismo Dios.

La misión del Espíritu Santo, enviado por el Padre en nombre del Hijo (Jn 14, 26) y por el Hijo "del Padre" (Jn 15, 26), revela que, con ellos, el Espíritu es uno y el mismo Dios. "Con el Padre y el Hijo es adorado y glorificado" (Credo de Nicea).

Por la gracia del Bautismo "en el nombre del Padre y del Hijo y del Espíritu Santo", estamos llamados a participar de la vida de la Santísima Trinidad, aquí en la tierra en la oscuridad de la fe, y después de la muerte en la eterna luz (Cf. Pablo VI, CPG § 9).

"Esta es la fe católica: adoramos a un solo Dios en la Trinidad y la Trinidad en unidad, sin confundir a las personas ni dividir la sustancia; porque la persona del Padre es una, la del Hijo es otra, el Espíritu Santo es otra; pero la Deidad del Padre, del Hijo y del Espíritu Santo es una, su gloria igual, su majestad coeterna" (Credo Atanasiano; DS 75; ND 16).

Inseparables en lo que son las personas divinas, también son inseparables en lo que hacen. Pero dentro de la única operación divina cada uno manifiesta lo que le es propio en la Trinidad, especialmente en las misiones divinas de la Encarnación del Hijo y el don del Espíritu Santo. *(Tomado de USCCB)*
