SAINTS

Introduction

All Christians are called to be saints. Saints are persons in heaven (officially canonized or not), who lived heroically virtuous lives, offered their life for others, or were martyred for the faith, and who are worthy of imitation.

In official Church procedures there are three steps to sainthood: a candidate becomes "Venerable," then "Blessed" and then "Saint." Venerable is the title given to a deceased person recognized formally by the pope as having lived a heroically virtuous life or offered their life. To be beatified and recognized as a Blessed, one miracle acquired through the candidate's intercession is required in addition to recognition of heroic virtue or offering of life. Canonization requires a second miracle after beatification. The pope may waive these requirements. A miracle is not required prior to a martyr's beatification, but one is required before canonization.

Key Terms

Beatification -- the second stage in the process of proclaiming a person a saint; occurs after a diocese or eparchy and the Congregation for the Causes of Saints has conducted a rigorous investigation into the person's life and writings to determine whether he or she demonstrates a heroic level of virtue, offered their life or suffered martyrdom. A miracle attributed to the person's intercession must be proved.

SANTOS

Introducción

Todos los cristianos están llamados a ser santos. Los santos son personas en el cielo (oficialmente canonizadas o no), que vivieron vidas heroicamente virtuosas, ofrecieron su vida por otros, o fueron martirizadas por la fe, y que son dignas de imitación.

En los procedimientos oficiales de la Iglesia hay tres pasos para la santidad: un candidato se convierte en "Venerable", luego en "Bendito" y luego en "Santo". Venerable es el título que se otorga a una persona fallecida reconocida formalmente por el Papa por haber vivido una vida heroicamente virtuosa o haber ofrecido su vida. Para ser beatificado y reconocido como Beato, se requiere un milagro adquirido por intercesión del candidato, además del reconocimiento de la virtud heroica o el ofrecimiento de la vida. La canonización requiere un segundo milagro después de la beatificación. El Papa puede renunciar a estos requisitos. No se requiere un milagro antes de la beatificación de un mártir, pero sí se requiere antes de la canonización.

Términos clave

Beatificación: la segunda etapa en el proceso de proclamar santa a una persona; ocurre después de que una diócesis o eparquía y la Congregación para las Causas de los Santos hayan llevado a cabo una investigación rigurosa sobre la vida y los escritos de la persona para determinar si demuestra un nivel heroico de virtud, ofreció su vida o sufrió el martirio. Debe probarse un milagro atribuido a la intercesión de la persona. (más la semana que viene)
