## **Reflection**

It does not enter the disciples' heads that the Messiah can be delivered into the hands of his enemies and be executed; they think that the Messiah must prevail over the enemies. This is why as soon as Jesus is silent, they immediately begin to discuss who is the greatest, surely thinking of the earthly glory of the victorious Messiah and the "distribution" of powers for his ministers. Jesus will take advantage of that circumstance to correct and indoctrinate his disciples about the meaning of their follow-up: "I have not come to be served, but to serve." The evangelist shows the difficulty of the disciples to understand that true greatness consists in serving, a difficulty that still persists today, because our human perspective considers that the one who serves is below, is not the first but the last, while the one who is served is in the highest position of society. The teaching of Jesus asks us to appreciate not honors but selfless service, service that consists of welcoming the most humble, the poor, the sick, those that society rejects and distances from, to serve in Jesus' ways.

**Homework:** Are you one of those that likes to be served? Or do you prefer to serve with love in Jesus' ways? Do you have difficulties to understand Jesus? What do you do to understand Him?

## Reflexión

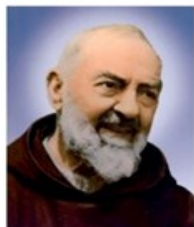

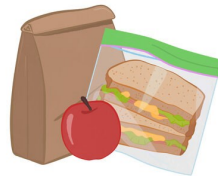




## Vivian's Circle
