The murderer who is in Paris France, confessed to the crime, as well as the location where he had thrown the body. Colombian authorities found the body (remains) of the father. Finally, Father Dario will be able to have a dignified burial, although without the presence of his father; since he died last month.

Reflection

This Sunday's evangelical message subtly presents us with an important truth about our practical life: every small detail well done has a meaning, a motivation and contributes to the story of life and salvation.

Works well done come from the grace of Christ. He who walks according to that grace does works that build the Kingdom. It is the details of every day, big and small, that give flavor to the life of the Kingdom. For example: give a glass of water, a smile, a word of encouragement, an invitation, a good example... There is also another detail that has its influence from a small point of view: the scandal. We must be careful not to make a scandal, for several reasons:

- The little ones (we could say small in faith) could be discouraged and that is a very strong damage. Let us think of the bad examples of the consecrated or the parents who do not help their children to walk in faith.

- Our religious sensitivity (represented in the eye) can be damaged bringing serious consequences in our relationship with God, consequently it would also damage our own identity as children of God.

Every scandal has its punishment. Also, every good work has its reward; that is why it is important to be careful in how we make our decisions.

Reflexión

El mensaje evangélico de este domingo nos presenta de modo sutil una verdad importante sobre nuestra vida práctica: todo detalle pequeño bien hecho tiene un significado, una motivación y contribuye a la historia de vida y de salvación.

Las obras bien hechas proceden de la gracia de Cristo. El que camina según esa gracia hace obras que construyen el Reino. Son los detalles de todos los días, grandes y pequeños, los que dan sabor la vida del Reino. Por ejemplo: dar un vaso de agua, una sonrisa, una palabra de ánimo, una invitación, un buen ejemplo... También hay otro detalle que tiene su influencia desde lo pequeño: el escándalo. Debemos tener cuidado de no dar escándalo, por varias razones:

- Los pequeños (podríamos decir pequeños en la fe) podrían desanimarse y ese es un daño muy fuerte. Pensemos en los malos ejemplos de los consagrados o de los padres de familia que no ayudan a sus hijos a caminar en la fe.
- Se puede dañar nuestra sensibilidad religiosa (representada en el ojo) trayendo graves consecuencias en nuestra relación con Dios, consecuentemente también dañaría nuestra propia identidad de hijos de Dios.

Todo escándalo tiene su castigo. También toda obra buena tiene su recompensa; por eso es importante tener cuidado en cómo tomamos nuestras decisiones.



