Did you know?

Did you know that our Archdiocese has 34 seminarians, and two of them are members of our parish? Well, for those who don't know, the seminarians are: Sean Lee, who recently moved to this parish, is in his last years of theology, and is currently at the seminary of St. Vincent de Paul in FL - the best seminary in the world because there is where I finished my studies; the other seminarian is well known to many of you - it is Will Brock, son of Kendyl and Butch Hunter and Warner Brock, and if the names of his parents do not sound familiar to you, how about Sherri and Fr Thad Rudd, his grandparents? Will is starting his studies at the Notre Dame seminary in New Orleans.

The annual budget for priestly vocations of Atlanta is \$1,800,000; for the permanent diaconate it is \$400,000.

This year's annual fee for St. Paul is \$30,300; at the moment we are short \$8,511.25. If I do not collect this sum by the end of the year, it would be the first time I haven't done so in my 12 years in this parish, but that is not the serious thing. The problem is that the Archdiocese will add the remaining amount to the main debt, which includes paying interest on that amount of money. The other problem is that I would be forced to fulfill my promise made this year (i.e., to watch the video three times, where the Archbishop gives his message to ask for money for the Annual Appeal of the Archdiocese).

I thank with all my heart all those who in the past made their contribution. Thanks to you, I am a priest of Atlanta. With your contribution, both Sean and Will as well as many other seminarians will be serving you and your relatives in the not-too-distant future. Making your contribution is not a waste of money; it is an investment in your faith and much more.

I need two big favors from you: pray for the seminarians so they are well trained and donate to reach the \$30,300 quota. If we receive more money, the Archdiocese returns it to us for the use of the parish.

Reflection

As we approach the end of the liturgical year and rejoice at the beginning of a new one, I hope, it is worth asking about the meaning of the expressions: the coming of God or the arrival of the reign. St. Mark answers these questions with apocalyptic language, which must be interpreted and placed in its context before taking at face value each of the descriptions, strong and shocking in themselves. These images, among other explanations, aim to show the end of evil in the world, to confirm the goodness of God in creation. Being prepared for God's call is the best thing that can happen to our soul, because no one knows the day or the time.

Question: How prepared am I for God's call? If God called me right now, where would I spend eternity?

Phrase: Those who are afraid lose more than those who try.

Sabía usted que nuestra Arquidiócesis cuenta con 34 seminaristas y dos de ellos son miembros de nuestra parroquia? Pues bien, para los que no lo saben, los seminaristas son: Sean Lee, quien se mudó hace poco a esta parroquia y está en sus últimos años de teología y actualmente está en el seminario de san Vicente de Paul en FL, el mejor seminario del mundo, pues allí culmine mi formación; el otro seminarista es muy conocido por muchos de ustedes, se trata de Will Brock, hijo de Kendyl y Butch Hunter y Warner Brock, y si los nombres de los papas no le suenan, que tal Sherri y Padre Thad Rudd sus abuelos? Will está iniciando sus estudios en el seminario de Notre Dame, en New Orleans.

El presupuesto anual para vocaciones sacerdotales de Atlanta es de \$1.800,000 y para el diaconado permanente es de \$400,000.

La cuota anual de este año para San Pablo es de \$30,300; en el momento nos faltan \$8,511,25. De no colectar esta suma para final de año, sería la primera vez de no hacerlo en mis doce años en esta parroquia, pero lo grave no es eso; el problema es que nos agregan la cantidad restante a la deuda principal, lo que indica pagar intereses por esa suma. El otro problema es que me vería obligado a cumplir mi promesa hecha este año (ver el video tres veces, donde el arzobispo da su mensaje, para pedir dinero para la campaña anual de la Arquidiócesis).

Doy gracias de todo corazón, a todos los que en el pasado hicieron su contribución, gracias a ustedes soy sacerdote de Atlanta. Con su contribución; tanto Sean, Will y muchos otros seminaristas más, estarán sirviendo a usted y sus familiares en un futuro no muy lejano. El hacer su aporte no es un desperdicio de dinero, es una inversión en la fe de usted y muchos más. Dos favores bien grandes necesito de ustedes, oren por los seminaristas para que sean bien formados y también hagan su donación para alcanzar la cuota de los \$30,300. Si nos llega más dinero, nos lo regresan, para uso de la parroquia.

Reflexión

Cercanos ya al final del año litúrgico y alegres por el comienzo de uno nuevo, eso espero, cabe preguntar por el significado de las expresiones: la venida de Dios o la llegada del reinado. Marcos responde esas preguntas con un lenguaje apocalíptico, el cual debe ser interpretado y ubicado en su contexto antes de tomar al pie de la letra cada una de las descripciones, en si fuertes e impactantes. Estas imágenes, entre otras explicaciones, apuntan a mostrar el final del mal en el mundo, constatar la bondad de Dios en la creación. Estar preparados para el llamado de Dios es lo mejor que le puede pasar a nuestra alma, pues nadie conoce el día ni la hora.

Pregunta: ¿Que tan preparado estoy para el llamado de Dios? ¿Si Dios me llamara en este momento, dónde pasaría la eternidad?

Frase: Pierde más quien tiene miedo, que el que lo intenta.




