What is the Epiphany?

The Epiphany of the Lord is a Christian celebration that means "manifestation". Referring to the Lord corresponds to the moments in which Jesus manifests himself or reveals himself to the world. It is usually identified with Three wise men however, in the Christian tradition there are at least three moments in which Jesus manifests himself. Epiphany to St. John the Baptist during Baptism. According to tradition, Jesus manifests himself to the Jews through St. John the Baptist during his Baptism in the Jordan River. The revelation of Jesus as the Son of God is related through a dove that represents the Holy Spirit. Epiphany to his disciples at the Wedding of Cana. It refers to the moment when Jesus begins his public activity and manifests himself through the so-called "miracle of Cana".

It is not enough to know where Jesus was born if we do not allow him to be born in our hearts. Jesus is born within us; he becomes the living God for each one. Today we are asked to imitate the three Wise Men; they do not debate; they left to meet the Son of God. They do not stop to look but enter the house of Jesus. They do not put themselves in the center but prostrate themselves before the One who is the center of our lives (Jesus). They do not stick to their plans but are prepared to take other paths shown by God. Their actions reveal a close contact with the Lord, a radical openness to him, a total commitment to him. With him, they use the language of love, the same language that Jesus, although a child, shares with them. In fact, magicians go to the Lord not to receive, but to give. That's why we ask ourselves: at Christmas we bring gifts to Jesus for his party, or do we only exchange gifts between us?

This week a little girl told her mother that she liked Santa Claus better, because he arrives earlier with the gifts, which is not true; before it takes longer time. The three Wise men bring gifts the first week of January and Santa Claus takes eleven months to arrive with the gifts (December). Some of them are in the Bible, the other is not.

¿Qué es la Epifanía?

La Epifanía del Señor es una celebración cristiana y significa "manifestación", y referida al Señor, corresponde a los momentos en que Jesús se manifiesta o se revela al mundo. Habitualmente se identifica con el Día de Reyes, sin embargo, en la tradición cristiana existen al menos tres momentos en los que Jesús se manifiesta. Epifanía a San Juan Bautista durante el Bautismo Según la tradición, Jesús se manifiesta a los judíos a través de San Juan Bautista durante su Bautismo en el Río Jordán. La revelación de Jesús como Hijo de Dios se relata a través de una paloma que representa al Espíritu Santo. Epifanía a sus discípulos en las Bodas de Caná. Hace referencia al momento en que Jesús comienza su actividad pública y se manifiesta a través del llamado "milagro de Caná".

No basta con saber dónde nació Jesús, si no le permitimos nacer en nuestro corazón. Jesús nace dentro de nosotros, se convierte en el Dios vivo para cada uno. Hoy se nos pide que imitemos a los magos; ellos no debaten, ellos partieron al encuentro del Hijo de Dios. No se detienen a mirar, sino que entran en la casa de Jesús. No se ponen en el centro, sino que se postran ante Aquel que es el centro de nuestras vidas (Jesús). No se quedan pegados a sus planes, sino que están preparados para tomar otros caminos mostrados por Dios. Sus acciones revelan un estrecho contacto con el Señor, una apertura radical hacia él, un compromiso total con él. Con él, usan el lenguaje del amor, el mismo lenguaje que Jesús, aunque niño, comparte con ellos. De hecho, los magos van al Señor no para recibir, sino para dar. Por eso preguntémonos: ¿en Navidad le llevamos regalos a Jesús para su fiesta, o sólo intercambiamos regalos entre nosotros?


